




Monster Profile


A special day with my family


Sunny



28th January, 2018


Cloudy

Gulliver as Health Ambassador


Gulliver became a Health Ambassador in Lilliput. He did many great things such as teaching the tiny people there how to be clean, tidy and polite.

My cousin is Christine Liu. She is five years old. She is short and also very thin. She is very cute too.






My Dream Holiday


The lost violin


A presentation about a Japanese custom
